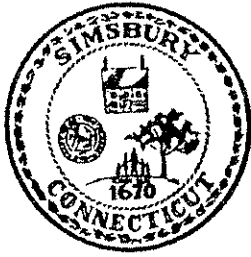

The Town reserves the right to cancel an event that does not obtain complete approval, as specified herein.

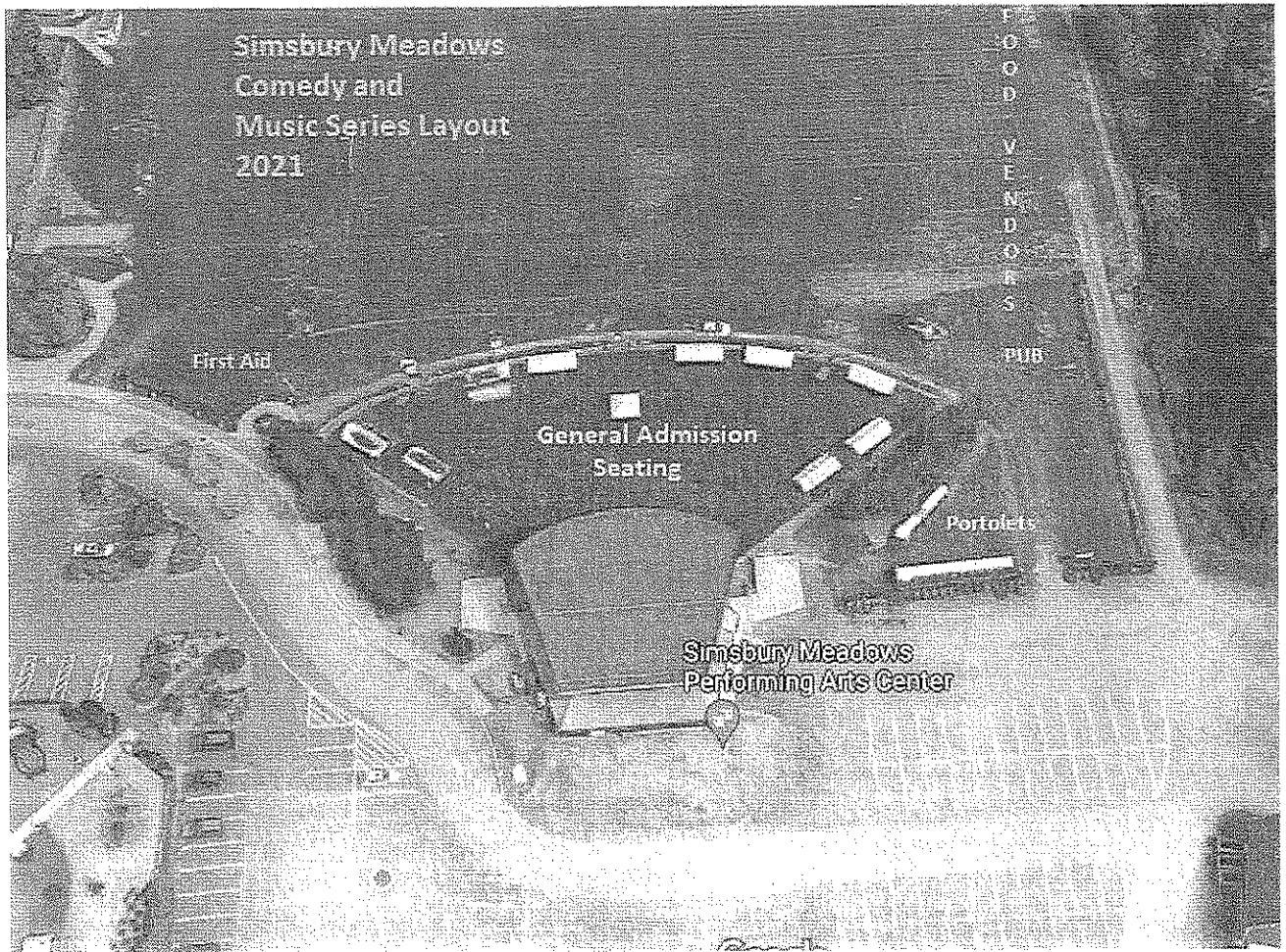
