CHARTER REVISION COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING June 14, 2011

I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Robert Heagney called the regular meeting of the Charter Revision Commission to order at 7:09 P. M. in Room 103 at Simsbury Town Hall.
