INSTALLATION OF BANNERS ACROSS HOPMEADOW STREET

The Town of Simsbury is soliciting bids for the installation of banners across Hopmeadow Street. The project work includes furnishing all labor, materials, equipment necessary for the timely installation of banners across Hopmeadow Street using the existing system of cables, poles and rigging.

Sealed proposals will be accepted by Sean Kimball, Director of Finance, 933 Hopmeadow Street (Rt. 10/202), Simsbury, CT until 10:00 a.m., June 6, 2017.

STANDARD INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS BANNERS ACROSS HOPMEADOW STREET SIMSBURY 06070

1. Project Overview:

The Town of Simsbury is soliciting bids for the installation of banners across Hopmeadow Street located near 885 Hopmeadow Street. This bid contract will be for one year with the option to extend for two additional one year periods.

The Town currently has banners that are hung by two volunteers. The process takes approximately 30 minutes. The banners are hung between two telephone poles that are rigged with wires and pulleys for easy application. In a typical year there are approximately fourteen (14) banners hung and removed. Most times when a banner is removed, it is immediately being replaced with a new banner. The Town imposes a two week limit for each banner being displayed.

The Town will notify the bidder of the need to hang a banner at least two weeks in advance. All banners must be hung on either Fridays or Saturdays. All banners will be picked up at the Town Hall. All banners must meet the predetermined specifications established to work with our existing system of rigging.

The proposal shall be for the labor of setting up these banners on the existing poles on a lump sum basis for each: installation, removal, remove and replace. Uniformed police officers will be provided for the control of vehicular traffic, at no cost to the contractor. Coordination with police and Town staff is the contractor's responsibility.

2. Scope of Work:

The successful bidder must furnish all labor to successfully put up banners for events and advertising across existing poles along Hopmeadow Street. The bidder must coordinate with the Simsbury Police Department to schedule a time to install the banners. All banners must be hung on Fridays or Saturdays. All banners will be available for the bidder at the Town Hall and will be notified two weeks in advance of the need to hang new banners.

4. Bid Submission Instructions:

- A. One (1) original and one (1) copy of all bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the bidder's name on the outside of the envelope and clearly marked "Sealed Bid for Town of Simsbury INSTALLATION OF BANNERS ACROSS HOPMEADOW STREET". If forwarded by mail or courier, the sealed envelope must be addressed to "Sean Kimball, Director of Finance, 933 Hopmeadow Street (Rt. 10/202), Simsbury, CT 06070". Bids must be at the office of the Director of Finance prior to 10 a.m., June 6, 2017. Postmarks are NOT an acceptable waiver of this policy. Once the first bid is opened, all bids are deemed final and no corrections or alterations may be made.
- B. Ditto marks or words such as "SAME" must not be used for the bid to be considered.
- C. All information must be submitted in ink or typewritten. Errors, alterations or corrections must be shown on both the original and all required copies and each must be initialed by the person signing the bid.
- D. Bids are considered valid for ninety (90) days after bids are opened. Bidders may not withdraw, cancel or modify their bid during this ninety (90) day period after bids are opened.
- E. An authorized person representing the legal entity of the bidder must sign bids.
- F. The inability to meet any specified requirement(s) must be stated in writing and attached to the bid form, or written on the bid form. If no exceptions are noted, it shall be assumed that the terms of the Invitation to Bid have been accepted.
- G. The Town of Simsbury reserves the right to waive any minor informality in a bid when such a waiver is in the best interest of the Town.

5. Questions:

Any questions about this project should be directed to: Mr. Thomas J. Roy, Director of Public Works by email, pubworks@simsbury-ct.gov or by mail Department of Public Works, PO Box 495, Simsbury, CT 06070. To receive consideration, such questions must be received at least five (5) business days before the established date for receipt of bids. No oral interpretations shall be made to any respondent as to the meaning of any of the bid documents. Every request for an interpretation shall be made in writing.

The Town will respond to all appropriate questions received via an addendum available to all prospective bidders. Such addenda will become part of this Invitation to Bid and the resulting contract. At least two (2) days prior to the receipt of bids, the Town will post a copy of any addenda to its website, located at: <a href="http://www.simsbury-ct.gov/finance/pages/public-bids-and-day-new-market-addend

<u>rfp</u>. It shall be the responsibility of each bidder to determine whether addenda have been issued, and if so, to download copies directly from the Town's website.

6. Presumption of Bidder Being Fully Informed:

At the time the first bid is opened, each bidder is presumed to have read and is thoroughly familiar with all bidding documents as well as all contract documents for this project. Failure or omission of the bidder to receive or examine any documentation or information concerning this bid shall in no way relieve any bidder from obligations with respect to their bid.

7. Pre-Bid Conference:

A Pre-Bid meeting will be held on site on Thursday, May 25th, 2017 at 10:30 AM to show the project work and discuss any concerns or questions bidders may have. All prospective bidders are strongly encouraged to attend.

8. Interpretation of Acceptable Work:

Banners are to be hung in a safe and professional manner in accordance with commonly accepted industry standards. The final appearance of the banner is to be neat and uniform. The Town of Simsbury has the final determination of acceptance.

9. Tax Exemptions:

The bidder shall be aware that the Town of Simsbury is exempt from Federal Excise Taxes and Connecticut Sales and Use Taxes. Appropriate tax exempt forms will be provided to the successful bidder(s) as part of the contract award process.

10. Insurance Requirements:

The firm must carry insurance under which the Town is named as an additional insured, as follows:

Such insurance must be by insurance companies licensed to write such insurance in Connecticut against the following risks with the following minimum amounts and minimum durations.

- A. Workman's Compensation, as required by State Statute & \$100,000 employers liability limit.
- B. Public Liability, Bodily Injury Liability and Property Damage Liability as follows:

Injury or death of one person: \$2,000,000

Injury to more than one person in

a single accident: \$1,000,000

Property damage in one accident: \$1,000,000

Property damage in all accidents: \$2,000,000

C. Automobile and Truck (Vehicular) Public Liability, Bodily Injury Liability and Property Damage Liability as follows:

Injury or death of one person: \$1,000,000

Injury to more than one person in

a single accident: \$1,000,000

Property damage in one accident: \$1,000,000

Property damage in all accidents: \$1,000,000

Insurance under B, and C above must provide for a 30 day notice to the Town of cancellation/or restrictive amendment.

Insurance under B and C above must be for the whole duration of the contract and for twelve (12) months after acceptance of the project by the Town.

Subcontractors must carry A, B, and C in the same amounts as above for the duration of the project and until acceptance by the Town.

Certificates of insurance must be submitted to the Director of Public Works prior to the signing of the contract and within ten days of notification of award of contract. Should any insurance expire or be terminated during the period in which the same is required by this contract, the Director of Public Works shall be notified and such expired or terminated insurance must be replaced with new insurance and a new certificate furnished to the Director of Public Works.

Failure to provide the required insurance and certificates may, at the option of the Town, be held to be a willful and substantial breach of this contract.

12. Awarding the Bid:

The Town reserves the right to accept any bid or any part of bids, to reject any, all, or any part of bids, and to waive formalities and informalities in the bidding process. The Town at its discretion will award the bid to the lowest responsible bidder. That bidder is the person or firm who is qualified and competent to do the work, whose past performance is satisfactory to the Town and whose bid documents comply with the procedural requirements stated herein.

13. Rejection and/or Cancellation of Bids:

The Town reserves the right to reject or cancel any and all bids, or any part of any or all bids, if such action is deemed to be in the best interest of the Town.
