1. CALL TO ORDER

The Regular Meeting of the Police Commission was called to order at 7:02 P.M. in the Police Department Training Room of the Simsbury Town Offices. a. Chairman's Report

The Chief provided the Commission with an update on the following:

- The status of the contract negotiations between the IBPO and the Town.
- The recent studies that have been done on portions of Hedgehog Lane that experienced accidents in the last three years.

- The State of Connecticut will be reviewing established speed limits in Town, but the process will take some time.
- The Department was contacted by only one of the individuals that had been offered identity protection after the recent accidental one-time publication of four social security numbers on the daily arrest log that is published online.
- The construction on the radio upgrade will begin in November.
- The Department's newest officer is doing well in the Academy, all reports received have been positive.
- Longtime Dispatcher Maureen Fallon has retired after 25 years of service.

c. Consolidated Monthly Report for August 2012 (Addendum 3)

Commissioner Goodfriend asked the Chief if the increase in the number of incidents had an effect on the Departments ability to respond to calls. The Chief indicated that call response was still good even with the recent increase in calls.

7. NEW BUSINESS

Commissioner Cosgrove asked for clarification regarding the release of the 911 call from the recent murder/suicide. The Chief explained that the

recording was considered public information and had been requested by one area television station, but so far had not been broadcast to the public.

8. AJOURNMENT

Commissioner Goodfriend made motion to adjourn at 7:42 P.M. Commissioner Cosgrove seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.
