ANNUAL SWAP SHOP/RC REPORT AND FALL 2023 MEETING

Decisions made 11-27-23, revised 11-28-23

- 1. Rubber tires at Swap Shop curb could be dangerous if knocked into someone ACTION: REMOVE.
- 2. Ribbons on beacon poll looked poor ACTION: REMOVE.
- Thom Roy may install one or two full-sized speed-bumps crossing the Transfer Station driveway, probably one south of the Swap Shop and possibly one north of the Shop following discussions with Paine's Inc. and after a best – location study - ACTION PENDING
- 4. The two handles with locks on Swap Shop doors may need replacement. Thom obtained a non-binding cost quote from Lock, Stock & Barrell of \$250 (parts and labor) but first he will study the matter further during the next, 2024, season.
- 5. Prohibited visitor problem to be addressed at start of 2024 season as only managers and Simsbury residents are allowed to utilize the Simsbury Swap Shop ACTION PENDING.
- 6. Petty cash expenditures (Handy Wipes, etc.) may now be deducted directly from petty cash income (visitor donations, Swap Shop scrap-metal turn-ins). Receipts are to be saved and an accounting provided in the Swap Shop Annual Fall Report.
