

WARNING: ELECTORS AND ELIGIBLE VOTERS OF  
THE TOWN OF SIMSBURY

The Electors and eligible voters of the Town of Simsbury, Connecticut, are hereby warned of a referendum to be held on Tuesday, May 14, 2013, pursuant to Section 406 Automatic Referendum of the Town of Simsbury Charter. In accordance with Charter Section 808 Duties of the Board of Finance on the budget, on April 9 and April 24, 2013, the Board of Finance held public hearings regarding appropriations for Fiscal Year 2013-2014. In accordance with Sections 406 and 808, the recommended operating budgets will be submitted to a referendum in the following forms:

1. Shall the appropriation recommended and approved by the Board of Finance for the purposes of paying the expenses of the BOARD OF SELECTMEN annual budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, be approved and implemented in the amount of \$18,347,575?
2. Shall the appropriation recommended and approved by the Board of Finance for the purposes of paying the expenses of the BOARD OF EDUCATION annual budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, be approved and implemented in the amount of \$64,918,869?
3. Shall the appropriation recommended and approved by the Board of Finance for the purposes of paying the expenses of the Sewer Use (Sewer Treatment Plant), Residential Rental Properties, Simsbury Farms/Special Programs, Non-Public Schools, Debt Retirement and Capital Non-recurring annual budgets for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, be approved and implemented in the amount of \$12,847,975?

A "YES" vote is a vote to approve an appropriation. A "NO" vote is a vote to reject an appropriation.

During regular business hours, the full text of each question is available for public inspection in the Town Clerk's Office, 933 Hopmeadow Street, Simsbury, Connecticut, and online at [simsbury-ct.gov](http://simsbury-ct.gov). The location of the polling place for the Referendum will be as follows: Henry James Memorial School, rear gymnasium, 155 Firetown Road, Simsbury, Connecticut. Electronic tabulators will be used. The polling place will be open between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Absentee ballots will be available in person at the Town Clerk's Office during regular business hours through May 13, 2013. Any person who is an Elector of the Town of Simsbury or any citizen of the United States of America of the age of eighteen years or more who, jointly or severally, is liable to the Town for taxes assessed against him or her on an assessment of not less than \$1,000 on the Simsbury Grand List dated October 1, 2012, is eligible to vote (CGS Section 7-6).
