Dear Simsbury Elector,

You may be eligible for permanent absentee ballot status. If you qualify, the Town Clerk's Office will mail an absentee ballot to you for each event for which you are eligible to vote.*

To become eligible, please send the following two items to the Town Clerk:

1. Your primary health care provider's certificate, written on their letterhead, stating that you are permanently disabled and cannot vote in person at the polls.
2. A completed, original absentee ballot application (ED-3) signed by you.

Deliver both items to the Town Clerk, Town of Simsbury, 933 Hopmeadow Street, P.O. Box 495, Simsbury, CT 06070.

Annually, the Registrars of Voters will contact you to update your status.

If you do not qualify for permanent status and still require an absentee ballot for this year's election, you may use a regular ED-3 application. Complete and sign the application; return it to the Town Clerk's Office.

*Please note: The annual budget referendum is not included as an eligible event for a permanent absentee ballot. A separate absentee ballot application (ED-3R) is required for each local budget referendum. You, or your designee, must pick up that absentee ballot in person at the Town Clerk's Office.
