Minutes of Special Meeting, February 4, 2016

The Special Meeting for the Simsbury Board of Ethics was called to Order at 7:01 p.m., a quorum having been determined by the Acting Chair.

A Motion was made to approve the minutes of the December 21, 2015 Regular Meeting by Board Member Tom Rechen and said motion was seconded by Board Member Kevin Crimmins. Said Motion passed by a vote of 4-0-1, with Board Member Drew Brazer abstaining as he was not present.

A Motion to Adjourn was made by Board Member Rechen and Seconded by Board Member Crimmins. The Motion passed 5-0, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
