The meeting was called to order at 12:06pm.

1) Approval of Minutes – October 29, 2021

The minutes of October 29, 2021 were approved by consensus.

2) Discussion of process and potential uses for ARPA funds

a. Non-profit application – recommendation for BOS

Ms. Mackstutis and Ms. Battos confirmed the thresholds that the work group previously agreed on. The total initial pool will be \$250,000, and organizations will be able to request up to \$25,000. Any requests greater than \$10,000 will be brought to the Board of Selectmen. Anything below that amount will go through administrative approval.

Ms. Meriwether offered two edits to be incorporated into the application. She noted that the award letter will further outline the specific responsibilities of the grantees. The group agreed that language should be added to the application to indicate that additional information may be required upon request.

b. Public survey

Ms. Mackstutis and Ms. Battos discussed pushing out a simple survey to the community in order to solicit feedback on any COVID-related needs. They agreed that the survey should be simple and specific, with the ability for people to identify the priority areas that they think we should be focusing on.
