The area of concern is the new sewer 22 line being installed on the southern end of Dyno Nobel. The reason for the re-alignment is due to the security 23 limited access to the infrastructure within Dyno Nobel. This will put the sewer line outside the security 24 zone allowing for easier access for maintenance. The area being disturbed is a previous environmental 25 cleanup zone and even though it has been remediated the soils on site need to stay on site. So WPCA plans 26 to dig a trench and refill with the soils removed. The area under the abandon rail bed in the area of a small 27 stream there will be jack pits to pull the pipe under those features without disturbing either feature. The 28 area of disturbance will be approximately 8 feet wide within their 30-foot easement. There will need to be 29 the removal of approximately 30 trees. The disturbed area will be reseeded with a conservation mix. 30 31 **Motion:** Commissioner Levey made a motion that the proposed activity is a regulated activity. 32 Commissioner Campolieta seconded, all voted in favor (4-0-0). 33 Commissioner Levey made a motion that the proposed activity is not a significant activity. Commissioner 34 Campolieta seconded, all voted in favor (4-0-0). 35 Commissioner Levey made a motion to approve application 21-21- 660 Hopmeadow Street sewer line 36 installation with standard conditions and the condition that a conservation mix be used to reseed the 37 disturbed areas.
