Board of Selectmen Town of Simsbury

The Performing Arts Center at Simsbury Meadows 2009 Season featured six Talcott Mountain Music Festival Concerts, a Cirque de la Symphonie Concert and a Reach Music Festival with Earth, Wind and Fire. The season's paid attendance exceeded 25,000. While the rainy weather negatively affected nearly every TMMF concert, the HSO management team expressed great appreciation for the facilities and the personnel support of the Performing Arts Center.

Overall, the PAC at SM ended the year with a loss of \$1,651 before Town labor allocations and depreciation. We must continue to improve operations in order to begin to cover the cost of Town expenses allocated to the Performing Arts Center. On Footnote 2, Detailed Expenses, a sum of \$10,090 was spent on fences and tables and chairs. These items have a life of at least 5 years, and \$8,072 of that expense might have been charged in future years, but the sum is too small to capitalize according to the Town's procedures.

At the end of the season, the PAC Board issued an RFP for a PAC Manager for the 2009-2010 Season. Academic Theatre Consultants has been selected to manage the PAC at SM for 2009-2010 Season. The principal, David C. Bell is a Simsbury resident who is highly recommended.

Attached is the 2009 Financial Report. It was prepared by John Wilcox, Asst. Finance Director/Asst. Treasurer, Town of Simsbury. It comprises a P & L for the year ended September 30, 2009 and a Balance Sheet as of September 30, 2009, together with three footnotes. The footnotes provide details for (1) revenues (2) expenses and (3) cost allocations.

The allocations of costs include Town employee time and GASB 34 depreciation. The actual Town employee costs are covered in their departmental budgets and do not represent a PAC cash outflow.

In accordance with the mandate established by GASB 34, the Town of Simsbury calculates depreciation schedules for fixed assets. This non-cash cost is a standard accounting practice designed to recognize that a fixed asset normally has a declining value over its life. The PAC Board has established a policy that the Performing Arts Center at Simsbury Meadows will operate on a positive cash flow basis. That policy means that operations will not be expected to generate real cash income to offset depreciation. Depreciation is used an indicator of residual life of the PAC assets. See Footnote 3 for the GASB 34 depreciation table.
