The proposed windows would be vinyl slider windows that slide left to right, have a full screen, and grills on the inside. They would look almost identical on the outside with the grid pattern being the same. The color would not exactly match the color of the house.
32 33 34		• Commissioner Nyquist was concerned about the appearance of windows with inside grills and suggested having the windows that can be seen from the street being left as is.
