- The proposed seed type is tri rye seeds and straw, and the applicant has proposed to use straw to stabilize the grading work during the fall/winter.
 - Ms. Winters recommends that the Applicant wait to begin the grading work until the spring due to concerns that the seed will not properly germinate given the colder temperatures. One alternative would be to utilize a soil tack fire.
