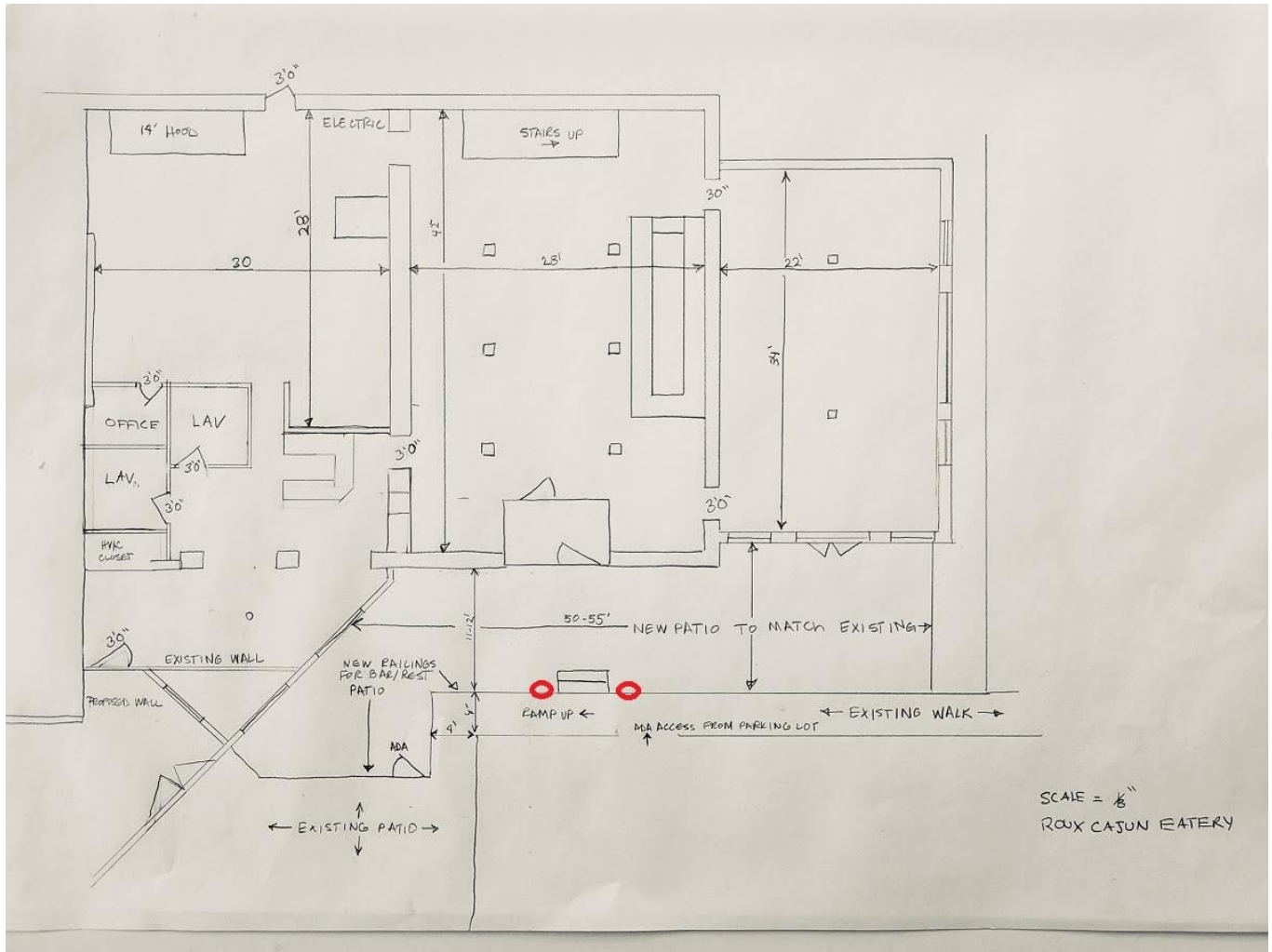

- 1) Tomorrow morning (1/4/2021) I will drop off the zoning application with the special exception fee of \$240 for liquor permit review.
- 2) I'm attaching the patio scale drawings. The patio will be across the front of the restaurant. The patio pavers will be identical to the current patio. Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns.



3) In discussion with other owners the state liquor commission does not require railings but the town makes that decision. Please let us know if railings will be required.

4) What are my next steps? From previous emails and conversations with you, I know I need town approvals before going to the state liquor commission. Is it easier to walk through the space together or talk on the phone or email? Whatever makes it easier for you.
