
RE: Application #22-41 of Lauretano Sign Group, Agent, for a +- 28 sq.ft. free-standing

sign to replace an existing sign at Bright Path Child Care located at 1 St. John's Place

(Assessor Map I06, Block 439, Lot 001), Zoned R-40.

Summary


Lauretano Sign Group is proposing to replace the existing free-standing sign for the Bright Path Child Care located at 1 St. John's Place. The +-28 sq.ft. sign meets the size requirements for a free-standing sign. The sign will replace the existing sign in the same location (near the intersection of Tariffville Rd. and St. John's Place), previously approved as part of a site plan.

Description of Sign Plan

The Applicant has submitted sign elevations in the Application packet. The free-standing sign would be fastened to the exiting poles:



According to Section 9.1, Signs in residential zones, a 32 sq.ft. sign is permitted for commercial uses once they receive a special exception. A child care center was approved in this location by special exception in 2006. The sign will be approximately six feet in height.

There are wall signs included in the packet however the applicant has not identified the specific wall sign location at this time. We are working with the applicant to clarify.
