Dear Mr. Hollis,

On behalf of Westminster School, I am submitting this site plan amendment application to allow for the construction of a student recreational and sports court gathering space to be completed in several phases of construction. The area designated for these improvements is set in the low-lying area near the center of the campus between the existing hockey rink and pickleball courts. The closest residential neighboring property to this area is over 1,000 feet away and blocked by a steep slope and a significant vegetated buffer.

The improvements include construction of an observation deck to the north and east of the existing paddleball courts along with a small warming hut. Just to the east of the deck will be a gathering space consisting of a stone surface as well as a pre-fabricated pavilion, measuring 24' by 30'. To the east is a proposed basketball court which will consist of bituminous paving and to the south of it will be a concrete throw wall and also surrounded by bituminous pavement. Between the area of the basketball court and the stone dust pavilion area will be a rain garden centrally located to collect stormwater runoff and promote groundwater recharge.

Access to this area will be provided via an existing paved trail located to the west of the project site that connects the upper campus as well as proposed steps that will closely follow the existing walking trail located to the south of the project site. The proposed steps will give the students a safer option to access this area than the current trail. An anticipated construction phasing plan is provided for reference.
