In the FY 2012/13 budget, two trucks were budgeted for use by the Parks Maintenance operation of this Department. The budget prices were provided by a vendor who supplies these vehicles to municipalities.

The combined appropriation for the two trucks was \$96,000. Due to the availability of these same two trucks through a State of Connecticut government program, there was a combined savings of \$17,953.

I am requesting that permission be given to use \$14,700 from the surplus funds to purchase a boom mower for use on the greenway, Tariffville Park, and other park and open space areas. This mower is similar to the roadside mower used by the town's Highway Department. This work is currently contracted out since we do not have a mower of this type. There is no funding in the future capital budgets for this item.
