Dear Ms. Glassman:

I am pleased to inform you that a grant of \$3,000 has been awarded to Town of Simsbury for the Cheese and Bread Day food program. This grant was made from support from the Beatrice Fox Auerbach Foundation Fund and from other funds at the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving to address basic human needs. Enclosed is check number 29115.


With the loss in jobs and sluggish recovery in Connecticut, many agencies report a continuing demand for basic services. Grants target the immediately needs providers see among residents which are often not adequately covered by existing resources. We have extended support to 65 agencies in the Greater Hartford region providing food, emergency housing, fuel assistance, access to healthcare, and employment services, totaling \$450,000 in grant awards.

Our Communications Department will issue a news release regarding these basic human needs grants. You are welcome to communicate the good news about your grant, but we do not require it. If you do decide to publicize the grant in any form, the text must be reviewed in advance by our Communications Department. 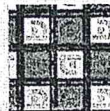
