

Green Tea to Undergo Renovations in June

Simsbury, Connecticut - Green Tea Chinese Restaurant, located at 570 Hopmeadow Street, will close on June 5, 2016 for significant renovations, and reopen with a new name and menu.

Owner James Chen is excited to overhaul the restaurant, which hasn't seen changes in more than a decade.

"We will have a larger, more extensive bar area with seating for up to 50, as well as a completely redesigned interior with private space for parties and events. We will also feature a new Asian-fusion style menu," he said.
