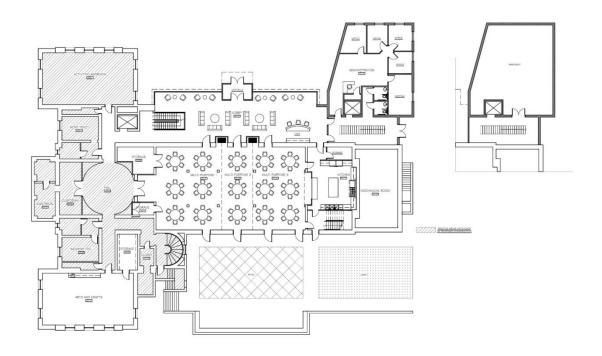

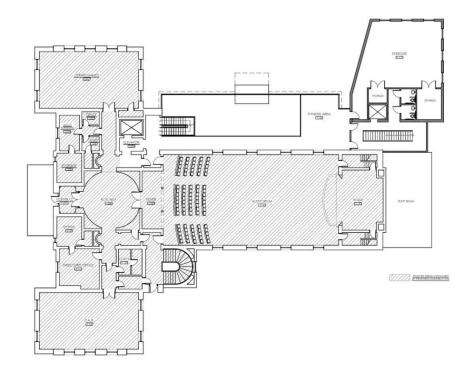
□ Plans - Scheme 3 - First Floor



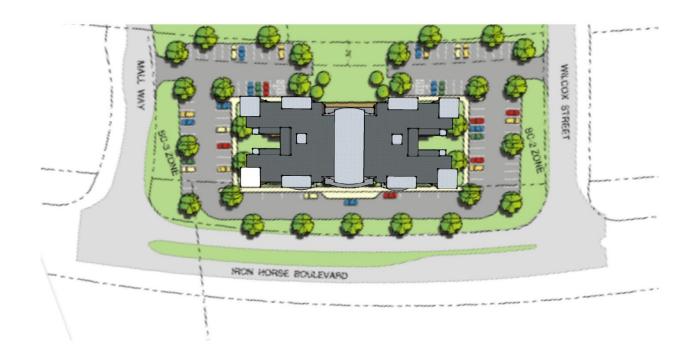

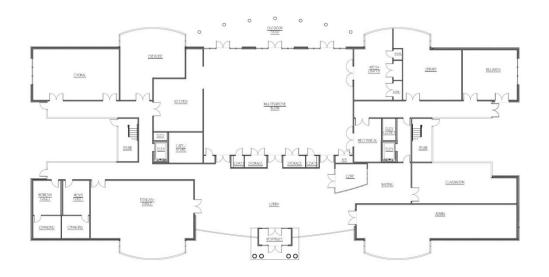


□ New Building – DOT Site

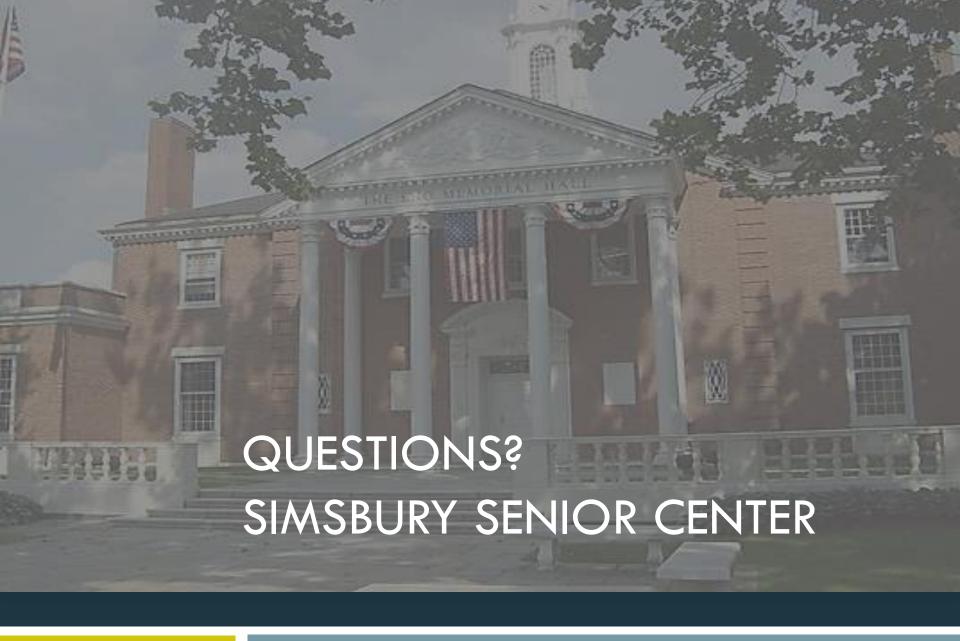
