The Town of Simsbury will be accepting bid proposals for the following project: **“Simsbury High School Turf Replacement” project** at Simsbury High School, 34 Farms Village Road, Simsbury, CT.

A non-mandatory pre-bid walk through will be conducted on Tuesday February 16, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. Interested parties shall meet in main office of Simsbury High School, 34 Farms Village Road, Simsbury, CT. All parties must present photo identification and sign-in at the main office.

A Bid Bond of ten percent (10%) of the bid amount is required. The selected bidder will be required to post Performance and Payment Bonds in the full amount of the Contract Sum.

Sealed bid proposals must be submitted in TRIPLICATE on designated forms and in designated envelopes. The envelope containing the bid shall be clearly labeled: **“Sealed Bid – Simsbury High School Turf Replacement Project”** and marked with the name of the Bidder on the front of the envelope. Bids will be received by Mr. Burke LaClair, Business Manager, at Board of Education Offices, Simsbury Town Hall, until 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, February 25, 2016 at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received late will not be opened.

The Town reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all bids, should it be deemed to be in the public interest to do so, and to reserve any and/or all other rights as detailed in the Contract Documents.
