



Medication Drop Box

The medication disposal program provides a safe and secure way for residents to dispose of expired, unwanted or unused medications 24 hours a day/7 days a week at the Simsbury Police Department. Residents may drop any type of medication in the drop box and remain anonymous. You can drop it off as is or remove the identifying material before dropping off the medication. There are plastic bags for liquids.

The medication drop box is a large green metal box in the lobby of the Simsbury Police Department. There is no cost to residents for this service.

Items not accepted:

- Needles, lancets or pen needles
- Aerosol cans
- Bloody or infectious waste
- Hydrogen peroxide
- Thermometers
- IV bags

There are some medications that can be very dangerous if taken accidentally, even in small quantities. Many medications can be harmful to the environment if disposed improperly. The purpose of this program is to protect the environment from improper disposal of medications, to prevent someone from accidentally taking medication and to prevent the illicit use of these drugs.
